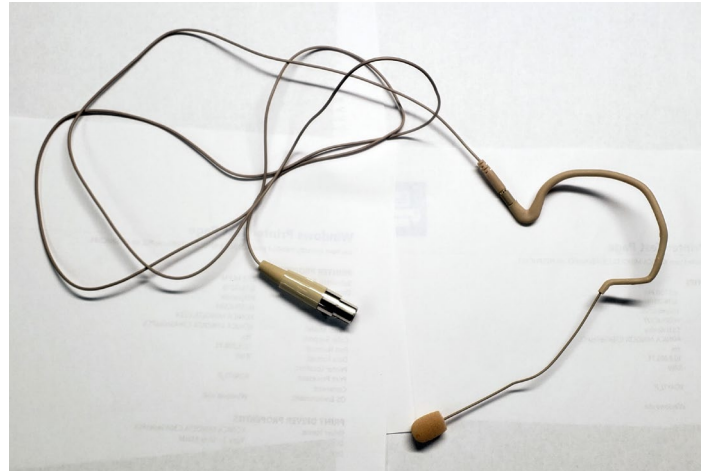


Using the OLLI Microphone System

Because we have a number of students who are hard of hearing, we strongly recommend that instructors use the microphone system in the classrooms.

We have several microphone options in the classrooms including a headset mic, a lapel mic, an over-the-ear mic, and handheld mics.

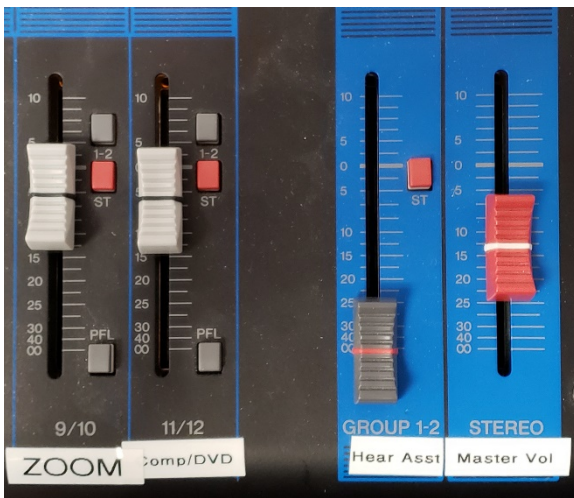


Over-the-ear mic

The instructor mic can be used with either the headset or the over-the-ear mic.

If you would like to switch between the headset and the over-the-ear mic, you can ask someone in the main office to assist.

To control the volume for the entire sound system, use the red Master Vol slider on the AV system.



If you are playing a DVD or YouTube video through the computer while using the microphone, use the Comp/DVD slider to change the volume.

If students are asking questions, we recommend giving them one of the handheld microphones
